

Sucking dust or dirt may cause troubles to the projector.
 If the ACF unit is not installed, power will be automatically shut down.


Replacing the ACF

- Before replacing the ACF
 - Press the power button twice to turn off the projector.
 (The power indicator will turn orange.)
 - Wait until the cooling fan stops and the POWER indicator turn to RED.
 - Disconnect the mains plug from the mains socket.
 - Prepare a Phillips-head screw driver.


Replacement procedure

Indicated replacement procedure below is for F300 series projectors. For the other series of projector, refer the Operating Instructions that is provided with your projector.


- 1. Turn the projector upside down and place it gently on a soft cloth.
- 2. Use a Phillips-head screwdriver to loosen 3 **ACF cover** fixing screws until the screws turn freely and remove the **ACF cover**.



3. Hold the pushes of the locking detents inward with fingers to release the lock, and pull out carefully the "ACF unit" from the body.



- * When you replace the ACF unit, clean the compartment and/or the Air exaust port if you need to.
- 4. Insert a new "ACF unit" into the compartment until it catches the both locking detents.
- 5. Attach the ACF cover and tighten the ACF cover fixing screws securely with a Phillips-head screwdriver.
- 6. Once the "ACF unit" has been replaced, press and hold the [ENTER] button for about three seconds on the [FILTER COUNTER RESET] submenu which can be selected from the [PROJECTOR SETUP] menu.



7. Press ◀ to select OK and press the ENTER button to reset the FILTER REMAINING to "0".

Notice:

Use this product with the "ACF unit" installed. If you use the projector without the unit, the power will be shut off in order to prevent a possible failure due to the collected dust and dirt.
