### VM-2Hxl Quick Start Guide

This guide helps you install and use your VM-2HxI for the first time.

Go to <u>www.kramerav.com/downloads/VM-2Hxl</u> to download the latest user manual and check if firmware upgrades are available.

# Step 1: Check what's in the box

✓ VM-2HxI 1:2 HDMI Distributor

1 Power supply (5V DC)

4 Rubber feet

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#### Step 2: Mount VM-2Hxl

Install VM-2HxI using one of the following methods:


- Attach the rubber feet and place the unit on a flat surface.
- Fasten a bracket on each side of the unit and attach it to a flat surface (see <a href="www.kramerav.com/downloads/VM-2Hxl">www.kramerav.com/downloads/VM-2Hxl</a>).
- Mount the unit in a rack using the recommended rack adapter (see www.kramerav.com/product/VM-2Hxl).



- Ensure that the environment (e.g., maximum ambient temperature & air flow) is compatible for the
  device
- · Avoid uneven mechanical loading.
- Appropriate consideration of equipment nameplate ratings should be used for avoiding overloading of the circuits.
- Reliable earthing of rack-mounted equipment should be maintained.
- · Maximum mounting height for the device is 2 meters.

# Step 3: Connect inputs and outputs

Always switch OFF the power on each device before connecting it to your VM-2HxI.





To achieve specified extension distances, use the recommended Kramer cables available at <a href="https://www.kramerav.com/product/VM-2Hxl">www.kramerav.com/product/VM-2Hxl</a>. Using third-party cables may cause damage!

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#### Step 4: Connect power

Connect the power cord to VM-2HxI and plug it into the mains electricity.

- Caution:
  For products with relay terminals and GPI\O ports, please refer to the permitted rating for an external connection, located next to the terminal or in the User Manual.
  - There are no operator serviceable parts inside the unit.

#### Warning:

- Use only the power cord that is supplied with the unit.
- Disconnect the power and unplug the unit from the wall before installing.

## Step 5: Operate the VM-2HxI

Acquire the EDID from a connected output:

- 1. Press and hold the EDID SETUP button to select the desired EDID.
- 2. The OUT LEDs illuminate in the following cycle: OUT 1, OUT 2, both illuminate (auto-mix) and both flash (default).
- 3. Release the button when reaching the desired set up. (If you set the machine to acquire the EDID from an output that is not connected, the default EDID is acquired)
- 4. The EDID is now acquired.

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
